***Pets an’ Me.*** Pets are cool! Campers will be introduced to animals that would make good pets. Campers will also learn basic pet care.

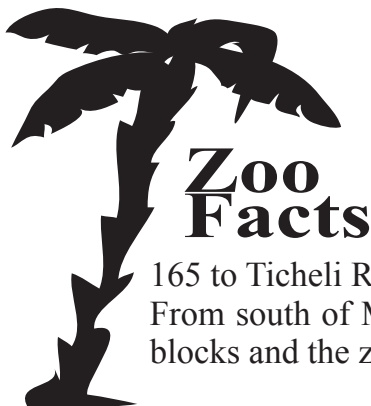
