- WHEN?** *Call for reservations! Check in time is 6:30pm and the program end at 9:00am the following morning. This is a lock-in therefore no late arrivals will be admitted due to safety. There will be security on grounds at all times.*
- WHY?** *Discover: What happens after all of the people leave the zoo? Which animals are still awake? Which ones are just waking up? Learn why conservation is important.
